


- Dwelling: The psalmist says: "You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand" (Psalm 16:11). Take time to be still and dwell in the Lord's presence. How does it feel to dwell in the Lord?
- Meditating and Contemplating: Try practicing the spiritual disciplines of meditation and contemplation outside of our sacred soul care time together. How do these spiritual disciplines provide a spirit of freedom and liberation in your soul?
- Resting: When and how often do you take a Sabbath rest? What are the benefits of these times? Do you believe you can accomplish more if you do not take time to rest? Why or why not?





- Silencing: Practicing the discipline of silence requires a tremendous amount of commitment to being content in relationship with the Almighty. Being with him in silence is a precious gift. What are some ways you can live a more consecrated life that includes the practice of silence?
- Commemorating: As the act of attending church is changing, the idea of koinonia (fellowship) is rapidly changing and becoming more diverse. What do you think community worshipping encounters will look like in the next fifty years?
- Resurrecting: Life can be messy, discouraging, humdrum... Nonetheless, the challenge remains to keep getting up, to keep rising, to keep resurrecting. What do you need to resurrect from, and what are your next steps?


Soul Care and Self-Caring

- Exercising: When it comes to being physically fit, what is God nudging you to do or keep doing?
- Journeying: Why is it important to journey alone with God as well as to journey with other people? Reflect on your spiritual journey. Have you noticed a sacred rhythm with God, others and self?
- Transforming: In Romans 12, the apostle Paul pleads with believers to live a transformative life. List three ways you can commit to seeking God to be a change agent in your life.





- Chastening: Maybe you have heard the saying, "If you know better, you can do better." God has put us in relationship with others in the faith community who have spiritual values but often fall short of fully engaging and living by them. How can you be an encouragement to someone who struggles with living a life of holiness?
- Welcoming and Centering Prayer: Many things vie for our attention. What are some ways you can guard your mind and so that the cares of the world and tomorrow's concerns do not overtake your thought space?






